Affinity Topics set for Eastern Video Expo 2018 By Stephanie Gibbons & Cindy Hahn, Co-chairs, Conference Committee

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At the expo you will have the opportunity to pick an Affinity Topic table and get some quality time with topic professionals to get your questions answered.

1. **Rights-of-Way**: Taxpayers shell out millions of dollars in infrastructure creating the "Public Right of Way". Let's talk about how this asset is utilized in your community. What is the future use of this resource and how will it impact our community? What are your community rights and what are the legal benefits that can be derived from effective use of the rights of way? Join Ken Fellman, (Fellman, Helmer, Conley and Kasselman) and get a clear picture of the new and changing landscape of "Public Rights of Way". 2. **Closed Captioning**: There is no question that providing closed captioning to our audience is a valuable service.
