As External Relations Chair, I'm searching for ways to rally our community to fight this threat—a threat that threatens our very existence. The Production committee did not meet in June. Bob Duthaler, Lee Beckerman and Geoffrey Belinfante had a meeting to begin to hash out a JAG "Elevator Speech" written by Geoff. If you are unaware of the concept, an elevator speech is a short pitch that one can give anywhere under any circumstances, including riding in an elevator with a potential client, that is short and concise enough that you could pitch the person and hook them ideally before the elevator hits the top floor (about 30seconds to a minute). We made good progress and plan to hold a second meeting to work on it. We plan to use the Elevator Speech as the basis of a JAG video to be used for the Website and to send out to potential members to help sell them on the idea of JAG.
